
New books (books which are two years old or less) will attract a new higher charge, newer magazines will also be slightly more. The full list of new fees and charges is available from our website.

We have had a lot of interest in Images of Tibet which was on display in the Cambridge Library. A combined presentation of images and podcast is now available on the library YouTube channel.
















Music Month Highlights
